Gary Chropuvka

Gary Chropuvka is the former president of WorldQuant where he contributed to the leadership of investing activities, global business strategy, and day-to-day business operations. Prior to joining WorldQuant in October 2020, Gary spent more than 20 years at Goldman Sachs and was a partner at the firm. Most recently, he was co-head of the Quantitative Investment Strategies (QIS) team within Goldman Sachs Asset Management (GSAM). Previously, Gary oversaw the QIS team's customized beta, tax-efficient and alternative risk premia businesses. He was also formerly a senior portfolio manager in the QIS Equity Alpha business. Gary began his career on Wall Street in 1993 in Morgan Stanley's Correspondent Clearing Group after earning a BA in mathematics from Rutgers University. He also has a master's in financial engineering from Columbia University and is a CFA charter holder.

Gary serves as a Trustee for Rutgers University and Chairman of the Joint Committee of Investments for the Rutgers University Endowment. He is also a Vice-Chairman of the Rutgers University Board of Directors, founding member of the Road to Wall Street Program within Rutgers and a member of the Rutgers Business School Board. Gary is the co-Founder of Baseable, a charity that focuses on promoting the game of baseball for individuals with intellectual disabilities in partnership with Special Olympics. He also serves as the Treasurer and as a Trustee for the Monmouth Medical Center Foundation.
